

### REGISTRATION

Registering for camp only takes a few minor steps. You will be ready for an incredible experience with us in no time.

- You can register online at nmymca.org/summercamps or by coming into the Welcome Center at any of our locations.
- When you register, there will be a NON-REFUNDABLE/ NON-TRANSFERABLE \$25 deposit required per week of camp registered for.
- 3. You can register up to 11:59pm on the Wednesday before the week of camp your child will be attending.
- 4. Camp balances must be paid by the Wednesday before a week of camp to ensure enrollment in camp.
- 5. If you have any questions, you can reach out to any of the camp directors for more information and answers.

### SIBLING DISCOUNT

The YMCA of Greater Nashua provides a sibling discount for siblings within the same household who sign up for the same camp week in the same camp location: Camp Sargent, Camp Create and Sports Camp. These discounts cannot be used in conjunction with any other discount or promotion and can't be transferred. This discount can only be applied by contacting our camp admin at camp@nmymca.org.

### **CREDIT / REFUND / TRANSFER POLICY**

1. \$25 camp deposits are non-refundable and non-transferable.

2. Requests for camp withdrawal MUST be made by email to the appropriate camp director or camp admin at camp@nmymca.org. All requests must be made no later than two (2) weeks prior to the camp's session start date.

3. You will be responsible for ALL balances on your account if we do not receive a cancellation request in writing by two (2) weeks prior to that week's start date, whether or not your camper attends.

4. Camps without sufficient enrollment may be canceled; an option of a credit or refund will be given.

 There will be no credits or refunds for personal absences, vacations, inclement weather, partial attendance, or missed camp days.

6. Prorated credits will be issued per directors' discretion for medical conditions which prohibit the participant from continuing in a camp. A doctor's note is required.

7. Transfer requests may be made providing there is an opening in the desired camp. All transfers must be made at least two (2) weeks prior to that camps start date. Requests can be made by email to the appropriate camp director or camp admin.

Transfers may ONLY be approved by respective directors.







### ArtNastics (Grades 1-3)

In ArtNastics camp, your child will explore their creativity and work their muscles in one fun, exciting camp. Campers will spend time in Tumble Town learning basic gymnastics skills such as rolls, cartwheels, and handstands, as well as balance beam and basic bar skills. Then it's time to get creative and head to art where they will move through different art stations.

### **NEW! Storybook Art (Grades 1-3)**

Campers will learn how fun art can be through the magic of books. Using book illustrations as a template, campers will experience art though storybooks and have the opportunity to discover different mediums and art styles.
