REGISTRATION

Registering for camp only takes a few minor steps. You will be ready for an incredible experience with us in no time.

1. You can register online at nmymca.org/summercamps or by coming into the Welcome Center at any of our locations.
2. When you register, a NON-REFUNDABLE/NON-TRANSFERABLE \$25 deposit (\$10 for Pre/Post Camp) is required for each registered week of camp.
3. You can register up to 11:59pm on the Wednesday before the week of camp your child will be attending.
4. Camp balances must be paid by the Wednesday prior to each week of camp to ensure enrollment.
5. If you have any questions, you can reach out to any of the camp directors for more information and answers.

SIBLING DISCOUNT

The YMCA of Greater Nashua provides a sibling discount for siblings within the same household who sign up for the same camp week in the same camp location: Camp Sargent, Merrimack Y, Nashua Y, & Westwood Park Y. These discounts cannot be used in conjunction with any other discount or promotion and can't be transferred. This discount can only be applied by contacting our camp admin at camp@nmymca.org.

Credit / Refund Transfer Policy

CREDIT / REFUND / TRANSFER POLICY

1. \$25 camp deposits (\$10 for Pre/Post Camp) are non-refundable and non-transferable.
2. Requests for camp withdrawal MUST be made by email to the appropriate camp director or camp admin at camp@nmymca.org. All requests must be made no later than two (2) weeks prior to the camp's session start date.
3. You will be responsible for ALL balances on your account if we do not receive a cancellation request in writing by two (2) weeks prior to that week's start date, whether or not your camper attends.
4. Camps without sufficient enrollment may be canceled; an option of a credit or refund will be given.
5. There will be no credits or refunds for personal absences, vacations, inclement weather, partial attendance, or missed camp days.
6. Prorated credits will be issued per directors' discretion for medical conditions which prohibit the participant from continuing in a camp. A doctor's note is required.
7. Transfer requests may be made providing there is an opening in the desired camp. All transfers must be made at least two (2) weeks prior to that camp's start date. Requests can be made by email to the appropriate camp director or camp admin.
Transfers may ONLY be approved by respective directors.



Farm Camp (Grades 1-9)

Combining hands-on farm education and sustainable living is what this camp is all about. Campers will interact with animals each day performing chores, learning how to care for them, and understand their importance on a farm. During their time in the camp, each camper will learn about planting, weeding, composting, and harvesting in our vegetable garden.

Pokémon Academy (Grades 1-9)

Have you ever wanted to bring your Pokémon cards to camp, but have always been told NO! Well here is your chance! Come battle with us. In this camp, campers will learn how to play the game, hunt for Pokémon around camp, and even create their own Pokémon cards. Let the battle begin!

NEW! Demi-God Training Academy (Grades 3-6)

Step into the world of gods, monsters, and heroic quests in this Percy Jackson-inspired adventure camp! At Demi-God Training, campers will take on challenges modeled after the training young heroes experience in the beloved book series. From "capture the flag" competitions to myth-themed obstacle courses, monster-tracking missions, and ancient-Greek-inspired crafts, every day feels like stepping into Percy's universe. Campers will explore the legends behind the characters, learn about Greek mythology, and team up with fellow "heroes-in-training" to complete quests around Camp Sargent's grounds and lake.

Harry Potter Camp (Grades 3-6)

Leave Camp Sargent Road and the Muggle world behind us as you transform into a student at Hogwarts' School of Witchcraft and Wizardry. This camp is a celebration of all things Hogwarts! Adventure awaits at Conquer It Camp, where teamwork, courage, and creativity rule the island! Campers will form "tribes" and take on daily challenges that test their minds, muscles, and teamwork skills — from obstacle courses and scavenger hunts to problem-solving missions and friendly competitions. Each day brings new twists and surprises as tribes earn points, build team flags, and work together to conquer the week's ultimate Survivor Challenge! Along the way, campers will discover the power of friendship, resilience, and the true spirit of adventure.

NEW! Game On! (Grades 5-9)

Get ready to bring your favorite video games to life — camp style! At Game On!
